

## 2023 Student Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) Sheet

- Summer @ City Hall (S@CH) is a six-week summer program taught by credentialed high school
  teachers with an emphasis on civic engagement and youth development principles. Students will
  engage in interactive group instructional classes learning about local government structure and how to
  become active members in their communities. Students will also complete a group project and present
  to the City of Sacramento City Council and the Sacramento Youth Commission (SYC). Selected students
  are required to attend virtually and in-person with no more than two absences during the six-week
  program.
- The <u>mandatory</u> Student & Parent/Guardian Orientation is scheduled for Saturday June 3, 2023, 10:00am 12:30pm. Instructional class sessions begin Monday, June 19 with an end date of Wednesday, July 26. The Life Skills & Speakers Series Workshops begin on Tuesday, June 20, with a completion date of all hours no later than Friday, July 21,2023.
- Weekly instructional classroom sessions are Monday through Friday 8:30am 12:00pm. The Life Skills
   Speaker Series Workshops are also weekly in the afternoons 12:30 3:00pm. Instructional classes and workshops are held at the New City Hall 915 I Street, Sacramento, CA 95814.
- During the S@CH program, students must attend instructional classroom sessions <u>AND</u> complete 42-hours of workshops to receive the stipend and five high school credits\*. (\*Students attending an eligible NUSD, SCUSD, or TRUSD high school will receive a stipend and five-elective high school credits. Students who do not attend any of these school districts but live within the Sacramento city limits are considered <u>At-Large students</u>. These students will receive the stipend along with a letter indicating completion of community service hours for their instructional classroom time instead of elective credits.)
